Report on the audit of the Standalone Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the annual financial results of M/s Rajasthan Tube Manufacturing Company Limited (hereinafter referred to as the 'Company") for the year ended March 31, 2022 and the statement of assets and liabilities and the statement of cash flows as at and for the year ended on that date, attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").
